

**Day 2 Istanbul****DESCRIPTION**

Breakfast. Departure to contemplate the spectacular panorama of the ancient walls of Constantinople and the Roman Aqueduct; We will also visit the old Jewish neighborhood in Balat and the Greek in Fener and contemplate the magnificent views of the "Golden Horn"; visit of the Cathedral of Saint George, main patriarchate of the Greek Orthodox Church; To delve deeper into the beauties of this imperial city and to perceive the breeze from the Bosphorus, we suggest continuing with the optional excursion "TOUR OF THE BOSPHORUS" which includes an incursion into the Mosque of Suleiman the Magnificent, designed by the Ottoman architect Mimar Sinan and which It has the largest dome of all the mosques in Istanbul. To fully enjoy the 4 senses, we headed to the Spice Bazaar, a place with special charm due to its color and aromas, the place par excellence to buy teas, herbs, nuts, typical sweets and of course spices. Our excursion culminates with a boat trip through the Bosphorus, the strait that divides the city between Europe and Asia, we will appreciate the wonderful views of the Ottoman fortresses, palaces, villas and the bridges that connect both sides of this city. **Day 3 Istanbul****DESCRIPTION**

Breakfast. Departure for a panoramic visit of the most emblematic cultural pearls of the city, works that denote the passage of the different empires through the city. We begin the tour with a panoramic view of the Valens Aqueduct, the most eminent Roman vestige in Istanbul. From there we will pass through the Walls of Constantinople, one of the largest fortification systems of Antiquity. We continue with the ancient Roman Hippodrome and we will see the Obelisk of Theodosius, the Serpentine Column and the Stonework Column and the German Fountain. The day will end with a visit to the Blue Mosque, so called because it has more than 20,000 tiles that adorn its interior. Free afternoon. The true "jewels" of the day can be known by acquiring the optional guided tour "JEWELS OF CONSTANTINOPLE and BASILICA CISTERN": Delve into the historic center of the city, where you can see the variety of vestiges of the different empires that shaped the current Istanbul. : the imposing Topkapi Palace, residence of the sultans and main administrative center of the Ottoman Empire; Hagia Sophia with its majestic Byzantine architecture and mix of Christian and Islamic religious elements; the Grand Bazaar, one of the largest and oldest covered markets in the world, where haggling is a tradition; the Basilica Cistern that has more than 300 marble columns that rise above the water. **Day 5 Cappadocia - Göreme - Cappadocia****DESCRIPTION**

Breakfast. Today we will visit this wonderful region with its fascinating and original landscape, formed by volcanic lava more than 3 million years ago. Visit the Goreme Open Air Museum, a monastery with chapels carved out of volcanic rocks and decorated with 13th-century frescoes. Visit the impressive valleys of the region with their "other planet" landscapes, having served as a movie set in the Star Wars movies. We also appreciate the views of the symbols of the geological formations of the region, the famous "Fairy Chimneys". We will make a stop to enjoy the incredible and extensive panoramic view of the Valle de las Palomas, which owes its name to the

numerous hills housed in the rocks, since in Cappadocia these animals have long been a source of food and fertilizer. We will visit the underground city of Cappadocia, one of the many impressive works of engineering built by ancient local Christian communities to protect themselves from attacks throughout history. At the end of our tour, we will visit a carpet center to learn about the artisanal production of these pieces that are true jewels. We will know in detail the drawings of each region of the country, the techniques and the handling of silk as raw material for a manual production that can take up to 2 years. Return to hotel, dinner and overnight.

Optional programs in Cappadocia: "TURKISH NIGHT" Presentation of folk dances in a typical cave with local drinks and "BALLOON RIDE" early in the morning to admire one of the most beautiful landscapes on earth.
